### **Payment Information & Tuition Policies**

An annual \$40.00 family registration fee is automatically charged to all 2017-2018 fall registrations. We go in and manually charge the price if you are a returning client once we receive the registration. There is no registration fee for summer camps. This fee is only charged once in a calendar year and is non-refundable. SCDC reserves the right to place all students according to age, ability level, and experience. We ask that all children be the age required for the class by October 1<sup>st</sup>. Tuition fees for the fall season will start on August 7<sup>th</sup>.

The dance season will consist of 10 months of classes with an average of 35-36 weekly class sessions from August 2017-May 2018. We offer a monthly payment option for your convenience.



Tuition rates are \$42.00 for a 30 minute class, \$60.00 for a 1 hour class, and \$75 for a 1.5 hour class. All add-on classes are \$50 additional monthly. We offer an unlimited tuition rate of \$210 per month. This will be changed manually by our office staff once you have surpassed this amount. We offer all first time boys FREE tuition for a 1 hour class. Any additional classes will be offered at a 50% discount. All returning boys will be charged ½ price for each class. We offer a 10% sibling discount for those families who have more than 1 paying child enrolled. This discount will be taken off the less expensive class. Monthly tuition is based on the average of 3.6 classes per month and is the same price for all 10 months. We go into each account and manually fix the tuition when there are multiple classes/students once we receive the registration.

Some months have as few as 3 weeks, others have as many as 5.

You are not paying for scheduled school vacations and holidays. Our calendar is based on the Lexington One School District Calendar. We will follow the Lexington One School District Calendar for Labor Day, Thanksgiving Break, Christmas Break, and Spring Break. We will be OPEN for all other holidays. In the event of inclement weather, we will follow Lexington One School District closings.

All tuition payments are due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of every month unless otherwise specified. Our NEW FREE auto billing system is required and will be automatically charged on the 1<sup>st</sup> unless you pre-pay BEFORE the DUE DATE at the front office. Our automatic billing system accepts Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and Bank Drafts. We accept Cash, Check, Visa, and MasterCard in our office. We cannot accept American Express at this time. We accept alternate credit card payments via phone. All tuition and company fees are non-refundable once made.

In October, you will be charged a \$50 costume deposit for each class your child is enrolled in. If you do not wish to order a costume and participate in the recital, you must let us know via email before October 1<sup>st</sup> to avoid being charged. The costume balance will be charged with November tuition. These range from \$5 to \$50.

All students registering after November 1<sup>st</sup> will automatically be charged the full costume fee upon registration. Costume must be paid in full before ordering. We cannot guarantee that costumes ordered late will arrive on time for picture week. After a certain date, costumes may no longer be ordered to make it on time for recital. Costumes ordered after Thanksgiving will not be here by picture week.

Competition team members will be charged a minimum of tuition and company fees automatically. Other fees may be added throughout the month and should be paid before following due date to avoid automatically being charged. We will make every effort to notify you if you have an unusually large balance before we charge the card. Cards that are charged multiple times a month may be charged additional fees.

Payments for tuition & other items may be made online, at the office, or by mail.

When making a payment by cash or check, please include the dancer's first and last name in the memo of your check, so we may credit the proper account. We can accept cash & check payments as long as they are paid prior to the due date or our system will automatically charge your credit card or bank account on file on the due date if there is any balance.

We have a returned check fee of \$35.

We do NOT send our monthly statements for tuition due. You may check your account online anytime by logging into the parent portal. Any discrepancies should be discussed with our office staff.

Any accounts unpaid after the (5) fifth of the month, even those whose auto-drafts come back declined, will have late charges assessed equaling \$10 per class.

Any student with an overdue balance of more than 60 days will not be allowed into class until payment in full is received or special payment arrangements have been made. Any account that is past due will be turned over to a collections office and is liable for an additional 35% rate fee.

We hate to see any of our students leave but realize that everyone will eventually grow up or move on to other adventures. As a courtesy to us, we require a written notice by mail, email, or to the front office before the end of the month if your child is going to discontinue their classes. If the written notice is not given, you will be charged tuition for the following month of dance. AGAIN, you must cancel /withdraw in writing BEFORE the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month or you are responsible to PAY for that month and any other month that passes until we receive written notice. We do not accept verbal withdrawals.

### **Class and Studio Etiquette**

Dance requires discipline so that training is a valuable activity. Disruptive behavior will not be tolerated. Any disruptive behavior, use of profanity, or ridiculing of other students will result in immediate dismissal from the class. Students and Parents must conduct themselves in an appropriate manner. Students must follow dress code policies. Please call the studio if you are going to miss a class or arrive late. STUDENTS MAY USE THE STUDIO PHONE TO CALL PARENTS. Cell phones must be turned off at the studio and at competitions and SCDC events. Facebook and other internet chatting services are used the parent's discretion, but will NOT be used at SCDC. NO PICTURES WILL BE TAKEN IN THE BATHROOM AND ANY OTHER PICTURES TAKEN AT THE STUDIO OR AT AN SCDC EVENT SHOULD BE APPROVED BY SCDC BEFORE POSTING TO ANY SOCIAL NETWORK. DO NOT TAKE INAPROPRIATE PICTURES WITH SCDC ATTIRE ON AND POST IT ON SOCIAL MEDIA. WE WANT SCDC TO HAVE A GOOD REPUTATION! SCDC is not responsible for damages caused by Internet chatting services.

PLEASE no food or drinks allowed in the dance rooms and/or lobby area. Please use our kitchen for eating or drinking. ABSOLUTELY NO GUM CHEWING during class. FOOD ALLERGIES: PLEASE BE MINDFUL THAT MANY OF OUR STUDENTS HAVE FOOD ALLERGIES. PLEASE AVOID SENDING ANY PEANUT PRODUCTS WITH YOUR CHILD TO THE STUDIO. We do honor and celebrate many holidays here at South Carolina Dance Company. If your child is unable to participate for personal or religious reasons, please let your instructor know so that can make alternate arrangements.

#### Insurance

All students are required to be covered by their own insurance policies. Students participate in SCDC classes and events at their own risk. All parents must sign a waiver and pay for the class before his/her child participates in classes/events. We do not offer trail classes for legal purposes and for the safety of your child. Refunds will be given at the discretion of SCDC if the child doesn't enroll. If an injury occurs, it is understood that the student's own policy is the only source of reimbursement. South Carolina Dance Company is NOT responsible for loss of any personal belongings.

### SPRING PICTURES/RECITAL INFORMATION

Pictures will be held in March at the studio and our annual recital will be held May 19th- May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at River Bluff High School in Lexington. Rehearsals will be held at the studio the week prior to the show. Participation in the recital is not required but students are encouraged to do so. All students who participate in the recital are required to order and pay for their costume (through the studio). A costume deposit of \$50 must be paid by October 1<sup>st</sup>. You may divide your payments or pay in full at the time of registration. Balances must be paid by November 1<sup>st</sup>. Costumes will NOT be ordered after December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2017. If you start a class in 2018, we do NOT guarantee you will have a costume for the recital.

Recital tickets will be available for \$10 at our front desk. Children 3 and under will be admitted free. The cost of DVDS will be as follows: 1 for \$25, 2 for \$45, 3 for \$65, and 4 for \$80.

### **Awards & Trophies**

Certificates and pins are given to every student upon completion of each dance year. First year metals are provided for each first year dancer. Trophies are given to students who complete 3, 5, 7, 10, and 15 years of dance training at a fee of \$10 per trophy. If you do not purchase a trophy, a certificate will be given instead. Years accumulated from other schools are transferable.

### **Private Lessons**

Private lessons are available for those students who would prefer one-on-one instructions with a teacher. All Privates, no matter who the instructor are \$30 per 30 minutes. Privates may only be scheduled through instructors. Privates are made payable to the instructor at the time of service.

### **Birthday Parties and Studio Rentals**

The studio is available for birthday parties. The cost is \$50 for rental. SCDC Staff members will be available to help for an extra fee paid directly to them. You provide your own decorations and refreshments. The studio may also be available to rent to individuals and/or groups for dance rehearsals (as space permits) at a rate of \$50 per hour.

All jazz/ballet shoes should be fitted with no more than half a thumbs length of growing room. Clogging and tap shoes are allowed to have a full thumbs length of growing room. No jewelry or street clothing are allowed in any class.

### **SCDC Dance Attire**

**Terrific Twos and Combo Classes**: Black or pink leotard with pink tights. Skirts are allowed. Or tight fitting tank tops, sports bras, or crop tops with leggings or booty shorts are permitted. If combination classes includes tap, please wear tights or send socks with your child weekly to prevent blisters. Hair must be pulled back securely away form the face.

Ballet Classes (ALL Classes): Black leotard and pink tights. No skirts are allowed. If you choose to wear a sports bra, it must be solid black. Hair must be pulled back in a tight and secure bun with a hair net.

Tap, Clogging, Hip Hop, Lyrical, Jazz, Acro and Dancenastics (ALL Levels): Tight fitting tank tops, sports bras, or crop tops with leggings or booty shorts are permitted. No loose or baggy clothing, please! Hair must be pulled back securely away form the face.

Combo Class Ballet and Terrific Two's: Pink Leather Ballet Shoes

Combo Class Tap: Black Patent Leather

**Combo Class Jazz**: Tan Block Neoflex shoes (If smaller than a size 10, Bloch Super Jazz are permitted)
